



EXTENDED OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Instructions: Extended Opportunity Scholarship application must be completed and returned to your admissions representative before the beginning of the start date you have chosen.

STEP 1: TO APPLY FOR THE PLATT COLLEGE EXTENDED OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP YOU MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- Be a first time applicant.
- Have a test score of 20 or above on the timed portion of the Wonderlic Test as administered under Platt College San Diego testing conditions.
- Submit a 500 word essay (minimum) explaining why you deserve the scholarship and why you would benefit from the training offered at Platt College San Diego. The essay should explain your desire to attend the College and your need to receive additional financial assistance to do so.
- Have an interview with the Scholarship Committee to communicate your motivations and dedication to furthering your education and pursuing a career in which you seek training but are in need of additional financial assistance.
- Apply for federal financial aid for the current award year and have an EFC between 2,301 and 19,830 and be ineligible for a PLUS loan.

STEP 2: TELL US ABOUT YOURSELF

Fill out the Extended Opportunity Scholarship Application. Your information will be kept confidential and shared only with the scholarship committee.

STEP 3: SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

Attach your application and essay. Submit it to your admissions representative. Incomplete applications or applications received without an essay will not be considered.
